First, we must learn how to play chords on the piano. Note reading won't do here because we're trying to create something original - something that requires the ability to

improvise. Now don't get scared! Improvisation is easier than you think and you can create **beautiful music with** *just a few chords*.

Both hands are called into play as we create a modern contemporary sound - the kind of sound that is used in much New Age piano music created today!

We learn how to play just a few chords in this lesson, but a few chords are all we need to create improvised New Age piano music. Once you have this large chord structure under your fingers, beautiful music is created; not by forcing or willing the creative act, but by letting it all go and **allowing it to happen!**
